**Attention all ABAF authors of oral and poster presentations**

You are invited to submit a full-text manuscript of your Advanced Batteries, Accumulators and Fuel Cells (ABAF 12) presentation (invited, contributed, and/or poster) to *ECS Transactions* (ECST), the proceedings publication of The Electrochemical Society. The full text submitted to the “*Proceedings of ABAF*” may be with proper formatting acceptable to *ECS Transactions* as well. All papers submitted to ECST will be reviewed to ensure that they meet generally accepted scientific standards. Any paper that is found acceptable will be published in an issue of ECST Volume 40.

The ABAF 12 ECST manuscript submission site is scheduled to open on [September 26, 2011](#). At that time, the corresponding author of your meeting abstract will receive an email invitation to submit a full-text paper. This email will contain the URL for the manuscript submission website and basic instructions on how to upload the paper. For detailed instructions on how to format your manuscript(s) for submission, please read the ECST Author Instructions ([http://www.electrochem.org/dl/ecst/ecst\\_a\\_inst.htm](http://www.electrochem.org/dl/ecst/ecst_a_inst.htm)) and follow the ECST Manuscript Template ([http://www.electrochem.org/dl/ecst/assets/ecst\\_temp.doc](http://www.electrochem.org/dl/ecst/assets/ecst_temp.doc)). **The site will close to the authors early November 2011.** Please, be prompt with your submissions.

The publication of the ECST transaction is expected in early spring 2012. Once published, full issues and individual articles will be available for sale, delivered as Portable Document Format (PDF) files.
